With Him, and in Him, and through Him, by the power of the Holy Spirit, with all who stand before You in earth and heaven, we worship You, Father Almighty, in songs of everlasting praise:

To Him who sits on the throne and unto the Lamb, be blessing and glory and honor and power forever. Amen.

We break this bread to share in the body of the Messiah.

Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread.

May the Spirit, Who overshadowed the virgin when the eternal Son came among us, make you joyful in the service of the Lord. **Amen.**

May the Spirit, Who set His disciples on fire on the Day of Pentecost, bring the world alive with the love of the risen Messiah. **Amen.**

And the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always. **Amen.**

Dismissal

Be filled with the Spirit, and go in the power and the peace of the Messiah.
